In addition to complying with the requirements of the RPS Group Environmental Policy, the RPS REM Offices are also committed to:

- Implementing, and maintaining an environmental management system consistent with the requirements of ISO14001:2004 Standard (& subsequent revisions) to achieve continual improvement.
- Maintaining compliance with all applicable environmental legislation and to other requirements to which RPS subscribes.
- Managing its significant environmental aspects, (i.e. energy consumption, resource use, and waste management) to promote conservation of resources and prevention of pollution.
- Setting of objectives and targets to mitigate the potential impacts of these significant aspects.
- Providing the resources to achieve these objectives.
- Wherever practical, employing the principles of reduction, recovery, re-use and recycling.
- Ensuring that environmental management becomes part of business practice and is considered in the financial planning of the organisation.
- Reviewing and auditing the environmental management system to ensure continuous compliance and improvement.
- Monitoring the environmental management system's performance against the objectives and targets, and report the outcome to the RPS REM Management Board.
- Conducting business with environmentally responsible contractors and suppliers.
- Communicating the environmental policy to its employees, its suppliers and its customers and making it available to the public.

The REM Management Team undertake to review this Policy Statement at least annually to confirm that it continues to reflect our activities and objectives.
