1. Desktop assessment report
2. Evaluation method statement & report

No archaeological impact

## Stage 2: Planning application

Planning application supported by relevant archaeological information.  
Consideration of impact development scheme on potential archaeological remains or monument

Planning permission refused

Planning permission granted with conditions to protect archaeology

## Stage 3: Mitigation strategy & implementation of development

### Written Scheme of Investigation of Programme of Archaeological work

- Final Report
- Publication
- Evaluation

Archaeological mitigation strategy-preservation in-situ; archaeological investigation, excavation

Planning permission granted with informative or no archaeological conditions

Deposition of archive

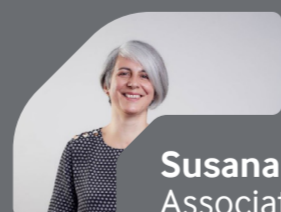
